This scholarship is intended to provide financial support for students entering his or her first year of college. Applicants should be well-rounded individuals with solid academic achievement. Scholarship eligibility requires student to be a graduating senior in the Keller Independent School District with the intention of using the scholarship within one year. To avoid forfeiture, *scholarship must be used by June 30, 2024*, unless prior special concessions have been made in writing.

The Greater Women's Club *Foundation*, a 501 (c) (3) tax exempt entity, was established in 1996. This allows the GKWC to direct its donations through the Foundation to non-profit organizations within our Northeast Tarrant County community, as well as the Scholarship Program benefitting each of the four Keller High Schools.

The Garden of Roses Fashion Show & Fundraiser, our annual fundraiser was held at The Bowden Events & Weddings in Keller, Texas on February 25, 2023, with the help of over 200 club members.
